This position works under the supervision of the Water Treatment Supervisor; operates and maintains water treatment plants and well field; monitors the watershed, supply, production and distribution systems; direct responsibility for water production; requiring knowledge of the operation and maintenance of municipal water supply and treatment facilities and equipment.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION REQUIRED: Three years progressively responsible experience in the operation and maintenance of public water treatment systems; ability to obtain Oregon WT1 Certification within 6 months of hire; graduation from a senior high school or GED

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT/LICENSES: Possession of a valid Oregon driver's license and acceptable driving record at time of hire; Oregon WTII certification within two years of hire

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of Level I, II or III Water Treatment Certificates at the time of hire; previous experience working under minimal supervision.
